(Technical) Short Courses guidelines suggested by D. Ruzic was presented, discussed and corrected during the STD meeting, (note the exact wording is in the presentation of D. Ruzic), 11 votes in favour

Extract from the minutes of the Education committee chaired by Miran Mozetic

"The Scientific Director, David Ruzic, proposed the following rules. The TSCs will:

- Normally be held in conjunction with IUVSTA organized or endorsed conference
- *Have to address a wide spectrum of participants (students, engineers, academians)*
- *Have to provide up-to date information which is not easily accessible from literature or from the web*
- *Maximum duration: 2 days, 8 hours per day*
- Financial support is to be given to attendees, not to lecturers
- Maximum grant per course 2.500 EUR

All members voted in favour so these rules were recommended to ECM. "

9. World Transfer Program

About WTP awards, the STD discussed the WTP awards. For the year 2014 there is no application was received. The STD decided to move the WTP to the guidance of the Awards and Scholarships committee to chair F. Richter. This procedure was proposed for voting, 11 votes were received in favour.
