1. Christoph Eisenmenger-Sittner opened the meeting at 17.45 explaining that the Chairman of the Committee, Ivan Petrov, could not be present. He presented the draft agenda which had been posted on the web; there were no changes requested and so the draft agenda was adopted.
2. It was reported that the activities under the remit of the Publications Committee were running smoothly; the Newsletter was proving useful and informative. Some Divisions had updated their areas of the website but some were still in need of change. The Acting Chair asked the attendees to look at the website and send any new content to Ivan Petrov. The area concerning Workshops, Schools and Conferences had been updated by the Scientific Secretary and so the scientific work of the Union was visible to visitors to the site. The Secretary General explained that he will continue to keep up to date information in the meantime area. National Societies had been very good in providing information for the Newsletter and a request was made for this to continue so the Union can continue to show its vitality. Additional ideas would be welcomed: David Ruzic said he hoped to see a paper produced from the forthcoming Highlights Seminars, László Kövér commented that the journal Applied Surface Science was interested in publishing some of the papers from IVC20 as it had done for IVC19 noting that this would require some negotiations between the conference organisers and the journal.
3. The Acting Chairman enquired if there were any items members wished to discuss under the heading of “any other business”; Dr Bhatti said that his International Vacuum Institute had

produced a nice set of experiments and planned to make a video of them and that a sample could be put on the IUVEST web site for download.

4. The meeting was formally adjourned at 18.00.
