"Educate, Inform, and Promote", 80 years later, the adventure continues...

March 25, 1945: 80 years ago, the declaration of existence of the French Society of Engineers and Technicians of Vacuum (SFITV) was published in the French Official Journal. It would become the French Vacuum Society (SFV) in 1973:

Its purpose: "to group technicians and researchers who build or use devices involving vacuum technology, this grouping having a dual purpose: friendly and mutual information in order to advance the vacuum technology."

SFV will organize a special event in Grenoble at the beginning of June 2025 in the frame of the technological exhibition called V2T (<u>Vacuum Technologies for Tomorrow</u>) where all foreign colleagues (free access) and all companies connected to vacuum are invited (still possible to take a booth).
